Letter of support to he consortium coordinated by Télécom Bretagne, l'Institut Mines Télécom (response to the call for network from generic ANR 2013).

This network gives new possibilities to expand our collaboration within a number of universities and institutions in France. In this network two research groups at the Department of Education will join forces, namely InterMedia and Transaction. In addition the medical informatics group at the Faculty of Medicine will be involved. These two groups are both engaged in interdisciplinary studies of learning, literacy and media-use in and across a wide range of school, leisure and work-place settings. The two groups have worked together in several projects. The two research environments have together approximately 30 participants (12 professors and associate professors, 4 post docs and 14 PhD students). At the national level the two groups have currently six projects from the research council of Norway and the senior staff take part in a number of international expert communities in the EC, in policy oriented networks on structural levels of the education system, and has taken a lead in networks on the Nordic level concerning a growing research interest in studying learning across sites and contexts.

We have been involved in a number of EU projects in the 5th, 6th and 7th frameworks. We participated in the Kaleidoscope Network of Excellence in Technology-Enhanced Learning and had the scientific manager from 2007-2008. And we had leading roles in the IP Knowledge Practice laboratory (2006-201) under the EU FP 6 programme, and the IP Science created by you (2008-2012) under the 7 FP programme.
